## How Maggie's Closet Works

<b>What:</b>	Maggie's Closet is St. Margaret of Scotland School's very own, in house, re-sale uniform shop.
<b>Where:</b>	See School Office for key and directions to the closet, which is located above the gym.
<b>When:</b>	Maggie's Closet is open during school office hours and during the Back to School Barbeque. Donations can be dropped at the school office any time the office is open. Volunteers bring donations to the Closet and sort them, when time allows.
